Fred Albertson, 68, Esteemed Resident Of Attica Area, Dies End Comes After Second Stroke; Rites Held Saturday P. M.

Alfred "Fred" G. Albertson, 68 years of age, well known farmer of the Attica vicinity for many years, passed away at 6:55 on Wednesday evening of last week at the home of his son, Harold, after suffering a stroke a few days before.

Mr. Albertson first suffered a stroke about two years ago. Although Mr. and Mrs. Albertson owned a home in Albany, they resided with their son following Mr. Albertson's first stroke, which rendered him more or less helpless.

Mr. Albertson was a lifelong resident of the Attica vicinity, having been born on the homestead farm Feb. 21, 1879, the son of Andrew and Christie Jacobson Albertson. On Jan. 21, 1903, he was united in marriage to Rose Zwickey, the ceremony taking place in Orfordville. They resided on the Albertson farm until five years ago, when they moved to Albany for a short time.

Mr. Albertson was a member of the Norwegian Settlement Lutheran church.

Survivors are the widow; one son, Harold, Exeter township; one sister, Mrs. Lena Lewis, Belleville; two brothers, Otis, Evansville, and Gilbert, Attica. He was preceded in death by twin daughters and a son.

Funeral Services Saturday

Funeral services were held at 2:30 Saturday afternoon at the Norwegian Settlement Lutheran church following private family rites at the Albertson home at 1:30, The Rev. Stanley Gjervik, Orfordville, officiated, and burial was in the Norwegian Settlement cemetery.
