MONTICELLO—Funeral — services for Richard Amelong, 41, Monticello, a former Monroe resident, were to be at 2 p. m. today at the Voegeli funeral home here, with the Rev. A. R. Achtemeier officiating and burial in Highland cemetery,

Mr. Amelong, who was recently suffering from a heart ailment, died at a Monroe hospital Sunday. He was born in Milwaukee July 15, 1899, and moved to Monroe with his parents when he was a boy. He was married to Hulda Blum in Freeport, Ill, May 21, 1922. He was a painter and a member of Monticello's fire department.
