Mrs. Alfred Arn, Monticello, Dies

MONTICELLO (Times _ Special) — Mrs. Alfred Arn, 71, died at 7 p.m. yesterday in her home here after a long illness.

The former Marie Goodman was born Sept. 13, 1887, in Canton Zurich, Switzerland. She attended schools in Switzerland and was married at Stadel, Canton Zurich, to Alfred Arn on Feb. 13, 1906. After their marriage they came to America and were at Farmers Grove cheese factory, York Township, for a year. They then farmed in Mt. Pleasant Township for a time and in 1914 moved to Adams Township. They retired to the village in January 1958.

Surviving are six sons and six daughters; Herman, Wilbert and Lawrence Arn, Monticello; Clarence, Pewaukee; Melvin, Portland, Ore., and Norman, Albany; Mmes. Sylvia Moritz and Dean Hilliard, Monroe; Mrs. Clara Hutchins, Colonia, N. J., Mrs. Robert Linden, Chicago; Miss Lorraine Arn, Milwaukee, and Miss Hilda, Newark, N. J.; a brother, Albert Goodman Sr., Irma, Wis.; 24 grandchildren and five great-grandchildren. Her husband died Oct. 27, 1958; a daughter, Irma Helen, in 1938, and a son, Walter, in 1954.

Mrs. Arn was a member of the Assembly of God church in Monroe.
