Paul O. Austin, Milwaukee, Dies

MONTICELLO (Times Special) — Paul O. Austin, 81, a retired clothing salesman, who lived in Washington Township from 1932-39, died at 3:30 p.m. yesterday in a Milwaukee hospital. He had resided in Milwaukee the past 17 years. The home was at 1303 North Cass.

Mr. Austin was born Sept. 14, 1878, in Sparta, the son of Benjamin and Mary Carlisle Austin. He and Marjorie Wallace were married June 12, 1918. They had lived in Oshkosh and then operated a women's ready-to-wear store in Waukesha. They moved from Route 4, Monroe, Washington Township, to Madison in 1939 and lived there five years before going to Milwaukee.

Mr. Austin was a member of Kingsley Methodist church in Milwaukee.

Surviving are his wife; a son, Gordon W., Milwaukee, and a daughter, Mrs. R. Thorton Little, Norfolk, Va., and two grandchildren. A brother preceded him in death.
