### **Mrs. Jacob B. Babler, 83, Monroe, Called**

Mrs. Jacob B. Babler, 83 years of age, a lifelong Green county resident, died on Wednesday of last week of old age complications in the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, where she had been a patient since Feb. 6.

Mr. and Mrs. Babler moved to the Churchill Woods Apartments in Monroe from Route 4, Monroe, early in April last year.

Anna Buehler was born Dec. 23, 1886, in New Glarus township, a daughter of Henry and Anna Blum Buehler. She attended rural school. On Jan. 3, 1905, she was married in Monticello to Jacob B. Babler. They farmed south of Monticello in Mt. Pleasant township for a few years and later farmed in Monroe township.

Mrs. Babler was a member of St. John's United Church of Christ, Monroe.

She is survived by her husband; two sons, Maurice J. and Kenneth, both of Route 2, Monroe; a brother, Henry Buehler, New Glarus; a sister, Mrs. Albert Moritz, Monticello; nine grandchildren, and six great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by two sons, Adrian and Roger; two grandchildren; and three brothers, Fred, John and Jacob.

Funeral services were held at 1:30 p.m. Saturday in the Stuessy Funeral Home, Monroe. The Rev. W. C. Koehler of St. John's church, officiated, and burial was in Greenwood cemetery, Monroe.
