

Ezra Babler
1874 – April 1909

Ezra Babler, of Monticello, died of blood poisoning in a Madison hospital Sunday noon. He had been at the point of death for some days. Blood poisoning developed following an operation for a disease of the jaw bone. The young man served with Co. H, of this city, during the Spanish-American war.

Mr. Babler was employed as electrician by the village of Monticello, being in charge of the village electric plant. He was a son of Henry Babler and was 35 years of age. A wife survives him.
