John C. Babler, 78, Dies Suddenly

Funeral services for John C. Babler, 78 years of age, resident of Monticello for more than 30 years, who died very suddenly and unexpectedly of an apparent heart attack . at 10:30 a.m. Saturday at his home, were held at 1:30 Tuesday afternoon in the Zwingli United Church of Christ.
