

**Robert R. Babler**  
**April 6, 1930 - Dec. 12, 1990**

Robert R. Babler, 60, Monticello, died Wednesday, Dec. 12, 1990, at St. Clare Hospital, Monroe.

He was born April 6, 1930, in Belleville, the son of Henry and Rose (Schmid) Babler. He married Georgia Zweifel June 16, 1956.

He was a petroleum distributor for Monroe, Monticello, Belleville and New Glarus for 36 years. He was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ and American Legion Post 256 in Monticello.
