

Rosa Babler

Dec. 27, 1873 - July 23, 1964

MONTICELLO - Mrs. Rosa Babler, 90, a resident here for the past 70 years, died Thursday evening in the Four Winds Manor, Verona, where she had resided the past 18 months.

The former Rosa Waelti was born Dec. 27, 1873, in Switzerland, the daughter of Jacob and Barbara Bieri Waelti, and was married in Monticello Sept. 16, 1892, to Otto H. Babler. He was a village blacksmith for many years, and predeceased Mrs. Babler, April 13, 1956. She was a member of Jehovah's Witnesses in Monroe.

Surviving are a grandson, Norman B. Steussy, Olympia, Washington; three great-grandchildren; and a sister, Mrs. Anna Baumgartner, Monroe. Two daughters preceded her in death.
