

**Alvin W. Baebler**  
**Feb. 25, 1919 - July 28, 1983**

Alvin W. Baebler, 64, Monticello, died Thursday, July 28, 1983, at his home following a lingering illness.

Born on the Baebler homestead farm in Mount Pleasant Township, Green County, on Feb. 25, 1919, he was the son of Vinzenz and Elizabeth Bryner Baebler. On July 16, 1948, he was married to Marie S.
