
Hollis J. Baebler

MONTICELLO — Hollis J. Baebler, age 71, of Monticello, a long time Green County electrician, died unexpectedly on Thursday, August 30, 2001 at his home.

Hollis was born August 26, 1930 in Mt. Pleasant Township, Green County, Wisconsin, the son of John H. and Lydia (Schlittler) Baebler. He graduated from Monticello High School in 1948 and married Shirley Rosheisen on February 16, 1951 at the Bethlehem Church in Brodhead. Hollis farmed in Mt.
