

Nona Baebler
April 13, 1905 - Feb. 21, 1980

Mrs. Nona Baebler, 74, Monticello, died Thursday, Feb. 21, 1980, at Pleasant View Nursing Home, where she had been a resident since Jan. 23. She had been hospitalized previously.

The former A. Nona Zweifel was born in Monticello on April 13, 1905, the daughter of John and Ann Marty Zweifel. She was a graduate of Monticello High School and the Whitewater Teacher's College. She had taught in rural Green County schools.

She was married to Henry V. Baebler in Monticello on Aug. 6, 1928. They were lifelong Monticello residents. Mrs. Baebler was very active in Monticello civic and church affairs and enjoyed working with the young people of the community.

Funeral services were held Saturday, Feb. 23, at the Zwingli United Church of Christ, with Rev. Charles Workman officiating. Burial was in Highland Cemetery.

She was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ in Monticello and the New Glarus Chapter 225 Order of Eastern Star and a past worthy matron.

Survivors include a daughter, Mrs. Gene (Betty) Webber, New Glarus; a brother, J. W. Zweifel, Browntown; a sister, Mrs. Sam (Fern) Duerst, Monticello; and two grandchildren, Kirk and Kara Webber, New Glarus.

Preceding her in death was her husband who died May 30, 1969.
