

**Gertrude Bartlett**  
**Sept. 2, 1874 - Dec. 22, 1942**

Funeral services for Miss Gertrude Bartlett, 68, life-long resident of the Attica community, who died Tuesday morning, will be Thursday at 1:30 o'clock at the Sharer Funeral Home and at 2. p.m. at Attica Methodist church. Rev. C. W. Emery will officiate and burial will be in the Attica cemetery. Miss. Bartlett died early Tuesday morning at the home of a niece, after a week's illness with pneumonia.

Pallbearers will be six nephews, M. E. Davis; Dempster Davis; Newton Davis, Marion Swann, Steven Swann and Roe Bartlett.

Miss Bartlett was the last living member of a family of eight children born to Joseph and Eliza Pryce Bartlett. Her father died in 1916 and her mother in 1920. She was born in Attica on Sept. 2, 1874, at Attica, where she spent all her life. The Bartlett's were pioneers in Green county, coming here in 1851 from Canada. The father was a native of Wiltshire, England and the mother a native of Wales.
