Rites Held Monday For Mrs. Baxter, 65

Funeral services for Mrs. R. A. Baxter, 65 years of age, Madison, who died Friday at a Madison hospital, after suffering a stroke the previous evening, were held Monday morning at the Frautschi funeral home, Madison, and at the Voegeli funeral home here in the afternoon.

The Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, pastor of the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church, officiated at the services here. Burial was in Highland cemetery. Funeral arrangements were in charge of the Voegeli funeral home.

Lora Wittwer was born in Monroe Oct. 27, 1887, the daughter of Gottfried and Ella Dick Wittwer. She was a graduate of the Monroe high school and attended the University of Wisconsin. She was a school teacher in Brodhead for some time. In 1911 she was united in marriage to Rollie A. Baxter. They lived in Brodhead, later in Monroe and then in Madison.

Surviving are the husband; one son, Fred, Mt. Kisco, N. Y.; one brother, Ernest Wittwer, Monticello; one sister, Mrs. Lee Dawley, Olympia, Wash; and two grandchildren, Susan and Jeffrey Baxter.
