

Hilda Bissig

Sept. 2, 1920 - December 31, 1978

Mrs. Roy J. (Hilda) Bissig, 58, of 221 11th Ave., Monroe, died Sunday, Dec. 31, in St. Clare Hospital, Monroe. She had been ill since Wednesday.

Mrs. Bissig, the former Hilda E. Hefty, was born in Mt. Pleasant township on Sept. 2, 1920, the daughter of Gustave and Clara Grossenbacher Hefty. On March 9, 1940 she was married to Roy J. Bissig. After their marriage, the couple resided at cheese factories near Monroe and Monticello. In 1950, they moved to the Grinnell factory and made cheese there for 19 years before moving to Monroe in 1969.

She was a longtime member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, and was a member of the church consistory. She was also a member and past president of the Green County Church Women United.

Mrs. Bissig was serving as vice president of Denominational Relations of Church Women United in Wisconsin. She was a member of Alpha Zeta Chapter, Epsilon Sigma Alpha Sorority, and the Marshall Bluff Bowhunters.

Funeral services were held today (Thursday) in Zwingli Church. Rev. Charles G. Workman officiated. Burial was in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.

Survivors include her husband; her mother, Mrs. Clara Hefty, Monroe; a daughter, Mrs. George (Judith) Ditzler, Fullerton, Calif.; a brother, Richard Hefty, Janesville; two sisters, Mrs. Edward (Anna Mae) Gibbons, Monroe and Mrs. Clarence (Lorraine) Whelan, Onalaska, and two grandchildren.
