Mrs. Hazel Blum, 53, Dies Wednesday; Rites Held Friday

Funeral services for Mrs. Hazel Blum, 53 years of age, New Glarus, who passed away Wednesday, June 4, at the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, where she had been a patient for some time, were held at 3 Friday afternoon in the Zentner funeral home, New Glarus.

The Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, pastor of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, officiated and burial was in Highland cemetery, Monticello.

Mrs. Blum had been in failing health for the past few months.

Was Bookkeeper Here

Mrs. Blum had been bookkeeper at the Voegeli Chevrolet Sales firm in Monticello for the past several years.

She was born in Jefferson township Jan. 8, 1905, the daughter of Harry Elmer and Mary Ellen Schwartz Sweetwood.

On Oct 20, 1936, she was united in marriage to Lawrence H. (Gabe) Blum, of Monticello, the ceremony taking place in Belvidere, Ill. Mr. Blum was a desk-man and deputy sheriff at the Green county sheriff's department at the time of his death in June, 1956.
