Jacob Blum, Age 93 Evansville. Succumbs

Funeral services for Jacob Blum, 93, Evansville, a native of the Monticello area, who died Sunday, were held Tuesday afternoon in the Roderick-Ward funeral home, Evansville. Burial was there in Maple Hill cemetery.

Mr. Blum had been at a nursing home in Stoughton for the past two and one-half years. He was the last member of his family.

Born Feb. 12, 1868, he was the son of Jacob and Susan Geiger Blum. In 1892 he was united in marriage to Kathrina Elmer. For several years they farmed in the Monticello area and then moved to the Camp Douglas vicinity, moving to the Evansville area from there.

Surviving are a daughter, Mrs. Louisa Blake, Ft. Wayne, Ind.; two sons, Herbert, Evansville, and Wilbert, Beloit; six grandchildren, 10 great-grandchildren, and three great-great-grandchildren. His wife died in March, 1949, and a son also preceded him in death.
