

## **Jacob Blumer**

**Dec. 21, 1868 - Nov. 22, 1952**

ORFORDVILLE—Jacob Blumer, 83, died at 2:30 p.m. Saturday in St. Clare hospital, Monroe, after suffering a heart attack.

The son of John and Maria Stuessy Blumer, he was born Dec. 21, 1868, in Washington township, northwest of Monticello. He was married Dec. 3, 1891, in Juda, to Ethlyn Lemon. They lived on farms near Monticello until 1917, when they moved to a large farm near Orfordville. Mr. Blumer retired from farming in 1946.

Mr. Blumer was the last member of a family of 14. He is survived by nieces and nephews. His wife died in 1954.

The funeral will be at 2 p.m. Tuesday in the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church, Monticello, the Rev. James Saunders, pastor of the Orfordville Methodist church, officiating. Burial will be in the Zwingli church cemetery. Friends may call at the Voegeli funeral home, Monticello.
