Lester John Blumer, 81, Madison, died on Friday, Oct. 27, 1989, at a local nursing home.

He was born on July 10, 1908, in Washington Township, Green County, the son of John and Verena Blumer. He graduated from Madison Business College in 1928 and married the former Hilda K. Altman on July 11, 1929. They celebrated their 60th wedding anniversary this year.
