Sept. 10, 1892 - Feb. 14, 1980

Anna Bontly, 87, former Monticello resident died Thursday, Feb. 14, 1980, at the New Glarus Home where she had been a resident since 1972. Death followed an extended illness.

She was born Sept. 10, 1892, the daughter of Anton and Celia Babler Bontly, at Popular Grove, York Township, Green County. She attended Monticello schools.

The last of her family, she had lived in Monticello until entering the New Glarus Home. She was a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, where she was confirmed in 1908, and was a former member of its missionary.

Preceding her in death were her parents, two sisters, Alma in 1918 and Sophia in 1978, and a brother, Otto E. Bontly, in 1963.

Funeral services were held Saturday, Feb. 16, in the Zwingli Church Memorial Lounge, Monticello. Rev. Charles G. Workman officiated. Burial was in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.

Pallbearers were Clarence Babler, Monroe and Herman Babler, Willis H. Babler, Thomas T. Brusveen, Lawrence F. Marty and Walter Tryon, all of Monticello.
