Joseph Booher Dies at St. Paul

Joseph Booher, for years a resident of Monticello, passed yesterday morning at his home St. Paul, Minn. according telegram received by Mrs. Frank Loveland, of Washington township. No particulars as to cause of his death were given the telegram.

Mr. Booher was born in this village and was about sixty years of age at the time of his death. His parents were among the early settlers in the village and for a time his father conducted a small general store in the old stone building which, up to two or three years ago stood on the corner of West and Highland streets.

Fifteen to twenty years ago Mr Booher moved with his family to Kilbourn, this state, where they remained until they moved to St. Paul two or three years ago. Besides the bereaved widow, he is survived by two sons, Chester and Edwin. One son, Robert, passed away a number of years ago. He is also survived by two brothers, David, of Janesville, and Anson, of Minnesota, and one sister, Mrs. Lucinda Walters, of Monroe.
