Mrs. Arthur C. Boss, 58, Monticello, died at 12:55 p.m. Friday, March 19, at St. Clare Hospital. She had been admitted as a medical patient, suffering a stroke March 14.

The former Margaret Ellen Krueger was born June 22, 1917, in Clarno Township, the daughter of Otto and Leatha Yeazel Krueger. She attended rural school near Browntown and on Oct. 4, 1940 was married in the East Wiota Lutheran church to Arthur Boss. They celebrated their 35th wedding anniversary last fall.

They farmed in Mount Pleasant Township for two years, then farmed in Washington Township west of Monticello until 1960 when they moved to the village. Mrs. Boss was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello, its Friendship Circle and Adult Fellowship and was a former choir member. She was a 26 year member of Mt. Pleasant Homemakers.

Survivors include her husband Arthur; her mother, Mrs. Leatha Krueger, Monroe Manor; three daughters, Mrs. Robert (Nancy) Briggs, Mrs. Keith (Janet) R. Field, Mrs. Kent (Joanne) D. Schwartzlow, all of Monticello; two sisters Mrs. C. Robert (Edna) Foulker, Monroe, and Mrs. Vernon (Inez) Workinger, Browntown, and six grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her father on May 12, 1953.

Funeral services will be Monday, March 22, at 1:30 p.m. in the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello with the Rev. Charles G. Workman, officiating. Burial is to be in Highland Cemetery.
