Joseph Brayton, Monticello, Dies

Joseph Brayton, 90. who had always lived in Monticello until he was cared for at the Wagner Nursing Home. died at 1:40 a.m. today at St. Clare hospital. He was admitted April 6 as a medical patient. Old age complications were fatal.

Mr. Brayton, who had worked as a section hand on the railroad and did road work, was born in Monticello Aug. 25, 1868. He was the son of Sydney and Mary Pratt Brayton. He never married.

For many years he resided with his sister, the late Mrs. Ed Wallom, Monticello who died July 22, 1955. He then lived with a niece, Mrs. Frank Riese, also of Monticello until entering the nursing home in 1957.

Surviving are four nieces and a nephew: Mrs. Riese and Claude Wallom, Monticello; Mrs. A. W. Peterson, Chicago; Mrs. Mildred Young, Poynette, and Mrs. Byron Long, Janesville. A brother, Elvin, died in 1947 and five sisters also preceded him in death.

Services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Wednesday in the Voegeli funeral home at Monticello. with Rev. Burton L. Holling of the EUB church officiating. Burial will be in the church cemetery on Railroad avenue. Friends may call at the funeral home after noon tomorrow.
