Rites Held Monday For Mrs. Brechlien

Former Local Lady Dies In Hospital Following Long Illness

Monroe—Mrs. Charles Brechlien, 74 years of age, Monroe, former Monticello resident, died Friday night at a Monroe hospital from a stroke. Mrs. Brechlien had been in poor health for the past five years.

Born in Stuttgart, Germany, she was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. August Milbrandt. She was married Feb. 28, 1899, in Dutch Hollow, to Charles Brechlien. Mr. and Mrs. Brechlien farmed in Dutch Hollow, a few miles southeast of Monticello until 1931, when they moved to Monticello. After the death of her husband, she moved to Monroe in 1943.

She was a member of the Emmanuel Evangelical church and of the Women's Missionary society.

Survivors include one son, Milton, Dutch Hollow; two daughters, Mrs. Erna Kuehn, Madison, and Mrs. Karl Geigel, Dutch Hollow; three brothers, Herman Milbrandt, Monroe, Henry Milbrandt, Monticello, and Charles W. Milbrandt, Troy, S. D.

Funeral services were held at 1 p.m. Monday at the Shriner-Neushwander funeral home and at 1:30 at the Emmanuel Evangelical church. The Rev. A. C. Rabehl officiated, and burial was in Greenwood cemetery.
