Milton Brechlien, 57, Dies Unexpectedly

Funeral services for Milton Brechlien, 57 years of age, who died unexpectedly Thursday afternoon while in New Glarus on business, were held at 1:30 Monday afternoon in the Stuessy funeral home, Monroe,

The Rev. Melvin J. Roehrdanz, pastor of the Immanuel Evangelical United Brethren church, officiated, and burial was in Greenwood cemetery, Monroe.

He was at a New Glarus garage having his car attended to when he collapsed and died of a heart attack at 3:40 p.m.

Mr. Brechlien had been a lifelong resident of the same Dutch Hollow farm, He was born Oct. 1, 1906, the son of Charles and Augusta Milbrandt Brechlien. On Oct, 23, 1930, he was united in marriage to Alma Stauffer, the ceremony taking places in Monticello,

He was a member of the Immanuel Evangelical United Brethren church of Monroe.

Surviving are his wife and one sister, Mrs, Theresa Kuehne, Madison. He was preceded in death by his parents and a sister, Mrs, Earl Geigel, Monroe.
