Mrs. Elton Bubb, 55, Dies Wednesday; Rites At Plymouth

Mrs. Elton Bubb, 55 years of age, a native of Mt. Pleasant township, died in a Plymouth hospital at 6:45 a. m. Wednesday after a six months illness.

The former Helen Purintun was born in Mt. Pleasant township on Aug, 12, 1910, the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Purintun. She attended the Babler rural school and graduated from the Monticello high school in 1927. She received a Bachelor of Science degree in education at Platteville State college. For a number of years she taught rural schools in Green county and also was second grade teacher in the Brodhead grade school. In 1950 she became second grade teacher in the Parkville grade school in Plymouth, where she continued to teach until she became ill in December.

On Aug. 22, 1953, she was married in Plymouth to Elton Bubb.

She was a member of the First Congregation United Church of Christ, Plymouth, and was also a member of the Wisconsin Education Association.

She is survived by her husband; two step-daughters, Mrs. Norbert Seham, Plymouth, and Mrs. Ernst Wusterhagen, Sheboygan Falls; one step-son, Selber Bubb, Plymouth; four grandchildren; one great-grandchild; her mother, Mrs. Katie Purintun; two sister, Misses Ruth and Florence, Route 1, Monticello, and two brothers, David Purintun, Janesville, and Paul Purintun, Everly, Iowa. She was preceded in death by her father and one brother.
