

**Anthony B. Carroll**  
**December 26, 1868 – October 25, 1953**

**A. B. Carroll, Aged 84, Esteemed Exeter Resident, Succumbs**

Funeral services for Anthony B. Carroll, 84, years of age, well known and highly esteemed Exeter township farmer nearly all his life, who passed away at 5 p. m. Sunday at the Masshardt convalescent home, Monroe, were held at 9:30 Wednesday morning at the Becker funeral home, Belleville, and at 10 at St. Mary's Catholic church there.

Mr. Carroll had experienced failing health for quite some time and had been a resident of the convalescent home for the past six months.

Mr. Carroll was born in Ireland in 1868, the son of John and Ellen Carroll. He came to this country when a young boy, the family moving to Exeter township, where he made his home continuously until about two years ago, when he began making his home with a niece, Mrs. Clark Smith, Madison.

For many years he and a sister, the late Miss Ella Carroll, resided on their farm, about four miles northeast of Monticello. The farm is now owned by Wilbert Stauffer,
