Old Pioneer Passes Away

1821 - 1905

Dennis Carroll, one of Green county's early settlers, passed away at his home in Exeter township on Tuesday last at 7 o'clock p. m., after an illness extending over a period of several weeks. The deceased had passed the mark of four score years and his death is attributed to advancing age and a general breaking down. Mr. Carroll was born in Tipperary county, Ireland, and came to this country when a young man, having been a resident of Exeter township for upwards of forty years. He was twice married, and besides his second wife he is survived by three sons and three daughters, namely: J. D. Carroll and Anthony Carroll, of Exeter township, Michael Carroll, of Albany; Mrs. Theressa Dodd, Fargo, N. D.; Mrs. Anna Whalen, Albany; Miss Mary Carroll, residing at home.

The funeral was held on Friday at 10 o'clock a.m. from the Catholic church at Dayton and was largely attended by sympathizing neighbors and friends of the family. Rev. Father Smith, of Brodhead, officiated.
