T. T. Cotherman Taken by Death

Thomas T. Cotherman, 65, Monticello, died at 7:30 last night in St. Clare Hospital. He had been admitted on Aug. 24 as a medical patient but surgery followed. He had had a long illness.

Mr. Cotherman was born in Washington Township, Green County, Jan. 21, 1901, the son of Ernest E. and Rose Wittenwyler Cotherman. He attended the Simmons rural school, near his home. On Jan. 18, 1921, he was married in Monroe to Marie Marti. He had farmed in Washington Township until moving to Monticello in 1952.

Surviving are his widow; his mother, Mrs. Rose L. Cotherman, Monroe; a son, Ernest C., Monticello; three daughters, Mrs. Henry C. (Rose) Elmer, Monroe; Mrs. Robert (Mildred) Lee, La Crosse, and Mrs. Duane (Carla) Lehr, Fayetteville, N. C.; four sisters, Mrs. Edwin (Florence) Theiler, Juda; Mrs. Alfred (Leora) Aeberhard, Monticello; and Mrs. Edward (Myrtle) Wyss, New Glarus, and Miss Rose Cotherman, Madison, and five grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his father, Feb. 25, 1957; a brother, John, Sept. 15, 1965, and a son, Carlyle F. Cotherman, Sept. 30, 1930.

Services will be at 2 p. m. Friday in the Voegeli Funeral Home at Monticello. Richard A. Kneifel, presiding minister of Jehovah Witness congregation, Monroe, is to officiate. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery, Monticello.
