

## Clara A. Crouch-Pluss

Clara A. Pluss, 77, formerly of 540 26th Ave., Monroe, died Sunday, March 13, 1994 in Monroe Manor Nursing Home.

She was born Feb. 17, 1917 in New Glarus Township, Green County, the daughter of Oswald H. and Rosina (Hammerly) Zentner. She was a 1930 graduate of Voegeli Rural School.

She married Nathan A. Crouch Nov. 30, 1935 and he died April 21, 1965. She then married Herman J. Pluss March 1, 1969 and he died Feb. 14, 1986.
