Mrs. C. Fred Disch, 76, Dies Tuesday After Long Illness

Mrs. C. Fred Disch, 76 years of age, esteemed Monticello resident, passed away at 8:30 Tuesday evening at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Adam A. Schuler, after a long illness.

Mrs. Disch had submitted to major surgery a number of weeks ago and failed to gain her former strength back.

Ellen Rose Streiff was born in New Glarus, Dec. 31, 1884, the daughter of Peter and Elsbeth Schindler Streiff. She received her schooling in New Glarus. On Dec. 17, 1903, she was united in marriage to C. Fred Disch, after which they farmed near Monticello in Mt. Pleasant and Exeter townships. She had lived in Monticello since 1848, moving here after the death of her husband.

Mrs. Disch was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello.

She is survived by one son, Frederick C. Disch, Monticello; four daughters, Mrs. Adam Schuler and Mrs. Arthur Escher, Monticello, Mrs. Russell J. Myers, Monroe, and Mrs. Frank La Porte, Glen Burnie, Md.;^o four sisters, Mrs. Robert Streiff, Mrs. John S. Hefty, Mrs. Emil S. Duerst, New Glarus, and Mrs. Elfa J. Voegeli, Monticello; 10 grandchildren, and two great-grandchildren.

She was preceded in death by her husband in December, 1943, and by a granddaughter, Kathryn Jean Myers, in 1946.
