

Albert “Bert” Edwards

1877 - August 9, 1932

Albany—Funeral services for Albert Edwards, 55, were held in the home at 1:30 p. m. Thursday and in the Methodist church at Attica at 2. The Rev. W. C. Snow of the Albany Methodist church officiated, and burial was in the Exeter cemetery west of Attica.

“Bert,” as he was familiarly called, was born in Exeter township and had lived in this vicinity all his life, excepting a short time he resided in Evansville. Two years ago Mr. and Mrs. Edwards moved from there to a farm in the Norwegian settlement, where he was taken suddenly ill from a heart attack Tuesday and was removed to Mercy hospital, Janesville, where he passed away after a few hours illness.

His parents, Frank and Eliza Jordan Edwards preceded him in death, also a brother. He married Miss Sylvia Whipple, who, with one daughter, Mrs. Oscar Olson, Brodhead, survives. Mr. Edwards was a member of the local Odd Fellows lodge.

B. C. Spangler, C. M. Dixon, and Albert Loeffel, of the local I. O. O. F. lodge, and Spencer McCready, Herbert Lee, and Ed. Sperry, of the Evansville lodge, acted as pallbearers.
