

Conrad A. Elmer

Conrad A. Elmer, 90, 703 22nd Ave., Monroe, died Thursday, June 18, 1987, at Pleasant View Nursing Home, Monroe.

He was born Jan. 7, 1897, in rural Monroe, the son of Adam and Mary (Prien) Elmer. He was a 1917 graduate of Monroe High School and attended the University of Wisconsin Ag Short Course in Madison.

He married Martha Waelti Dec. 8, 1917, at St. John's United Church of Christ with the late Rev. P. A. Schuh officiating.

He was a farmer in the Dutch Hollow area before retiring to Monroe in 1976. He was an Army veteran of World War I and a former Monroe Moose Lodge member.

Survivors include his wife, Martha, at home; a son, Conrad F. Elmer, Monticello; a daughter, Mrs. Tom (Mardelle) Holyoke. Monroe; two grandchildren, two step-grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.

Preceding him in death were a grandson, a brother in infancy and three sisters, Cora Berryman, Viola Coplien and Elmyra McDearman.

Family services were held Monday at Shriner-Neuenschwander Funeral Home, Monroe, with the Rev. Charles Workman, Monticello officiating. Burial was in Greenwood Cemetery, Monroe.
