Fred C. Elmer, Jr., 64, Retired Exeter Farmer, Succumbs

Funeral services for Fred C. Elmer, Jr, 64 years of age, a prominent Exeter township farmer for many years, who passed away at 7:30 Friday morning at the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, after two years of failing health, were held at 2 Monday afternoon in the Zwingli United Church of Christ here.

The Rev. A. R. Achtemeier, church pastor, officiated. and burial was in Highland cemetery. Pallbearers were Allen Fjelstad, Belleville, Milton Krueger, Gary Lewis, Evansville, Roger Krueger, Brooklyn, Robert C. Grossen and Albert Richard.

Born in Monticello on Dec. 9, 1893, Mr. Elmer was the son of Fred and Susanna Zentner Elmer. He attended rural school in Exeter township. On Dec. 27, 1923, he was united in marriage to Flossie Kundert, the ceremony taking place in Monroe.

Mr. and Mrs. Elmer had always farmed in Exeter township until last March when they sold their farm. They continued to live on the farm, however, until September, when they moved to Monticello, having purchased the Fred C. Durtschi home.

Mr Elmer served as treasurer of the Exeter school district for many years. He was a member of the Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello.

He is Survived by his wife; his mother, and one sister, Mrs Mary Bandi, New Glarus. He was preceded in death by his father, June 20, 1936.
