

Herman W. Elmer
July 8, 1903 - Feb. 21, 1976

Funeral services were held Tuesday, Feb. 24, at 2 p.m. in the Swiss United Church of Christ, New Glarus, for Herman W. Elmer, 72, New Glarus, who died at his home on Saturday, Feb. 21. Rev. Linus Wierwill officiated and burial was in the Swiss Church Cemetery.

Mr. Elmer was born in Monticello on July 8, 1903, the son of Jacob and Katherine Elmer. He and the former Alice Duerst were married in 1927. They had lived in the New Glarus, Monticello and Monroe areas. He worked for the Triangle Cheese Co. in Monroe.
