Fred W. Feldt, Aged 80, Monroe, Dies

Rites Held Saturday P. M. For Former Mt. Pleasant Township Farmer

Monroe—Fred W. Feldt, aged 80, former Mt. Pleasant township farmer and a resident of Monroe for many years, passed away last Thursday in the Monroe hospital of a heart attack. Mr. Feldt had been ill for two years.

The son of Mr. and Mrs. August Feldt, he was born in Pommerin, Germany, March 25, 1866. In 1873 he came to the United States with his parents, the family settling in Sylvester township. On Dec. 21, 1891, he was married in Dutch Hollow to Ernestine Staley.

He farmed in Mt. Pleasant township for 28 years, residing about three miles south of Monticello. Upon their retirement in 1919, Mr. and Mrs. Feldt moved to Monroe.

He was a member of the Emmanuel Evangelical church.

Survivors include his wife; three daughters, Mrs. J. L. Babler and Mrs. John Kubly, Monroe, and Mrs. Fred H. Hahlen, Brodhead; two sons, Ben F. Feldt, Monticello, and Harvey A. Feldt, Madison, four brothers, Frank and August, Monroe, and John and Edward, Evansville, and two sisters, Mrs. Herman Ladwig, Monroe, and Mrs. William Luchsinger, Evansville.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Saturday at the Emmanuel Evangelical church, the Rev. Alvin C. Rabehl officiating, Burial was in Greenwood cemetery,
