ILLNESS IS FATAL TO MRS. ADOLPH FELLER

Monroe — Funeral services for Mrs. Adolph Feller, 50, Washington township, who died at her farm home Tuesday after being ill a year, will be held at 1 p. m. Friday at her farm home and at 2 p. m. in the German Reformed church at Monticello. The Rev. Albert Muehlmeier, pastor, will officiate and burial will be in the Monticello (Highland) cemetery.

A native of Switzerland, the former Miss Emma Feller was married in Switzerland to Adolph Feller March 4, 1910. Following their marriage the couple moved to Green county, where they have since resided. They lived in Washington and Mt. Pleasant townships.

Besides her husband she is survived by two sons, Rudolph, Argyle, and Robert, Monticello; two daughters, Miss Hulda at home and Mrs. Raymond Campbell, Clarno township; a grandchild; three sisters, Mrs. Bertha Schneider, in Switzerland, Mrs. Carl Laubscher, Dundee, O., and Mrs. Fred Laubscher, Dow City, Ia.; a brother, Hans Feller, and a half brother, Gottfried Wenger, both in Switzerland.
