January 19, 1911 - November 16, 2004

Rudolph Feller, age 93, of Oxford, Mississippi, formerly of Monticello and Monroe, died on Tuesday, November 16, 2004, at Baptist Memorial Hospital in Oxford. Rudy was born January 19, 1911 in Monticello, Wisconsin, the son of Adolph and Emma (Feller) Feller. He married Helen C. Regez on June 2, 1934 in Freeport, Illinois. Rudy farmed in Adams, Washington, and Mt. Pleasant Townships for 29 years — and subsequently worked part time at the Washington Mill and Deppeler Cheese Factory. Rudy and Helen made their home in Washington Township, Green County, until moving to Monroe in 1985 and Oxford, Miss. in 1996.

He is a member of Zwingli United Church of Christ, Monticello.

Survivors include a son, Dennis (Grace) Feller of Oxford, Miss.; two grandchildren, Renee (Jeffrey) Hallam of Oxford, Miss. and Jay (Wendy) Feller of Columbus, Ohio; six great-grandchildren: Mitchell, Tyler, and Nathan Hallam and Justin, Jack, and Valerie Feller; a brother, Robert Feller of New Glarus; and a sister, Hulda Dix of Marshfield.
