Kenneth Fenton, Monticello, Dies

Kenneth A. Fenton, 51, died Sunday at 8 a. m. in St. Clare hospital following a six months illness. He had been a patient at the hospital five days.

Mr. Fenton was born Oct. 18. 1902, in Brooklyn Township, the son of Gaylord and Minnie Nesbit Fenton. He attended the Townline school.

On Nov. 29, 1938, he was married in Nashua, Ia., to Rose Marty and they lived in Monticello.
