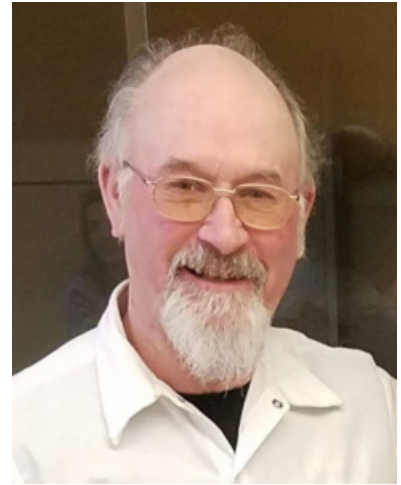


Gaylord G. Flannery

Gaylord G. Flannery, age 70 of Monticello died, Friday June 24, 2022 at U.W. Hospital in Madison. He was born on October 14, 1951 in Green County, Wisconsin, the son of Glen and Charlene (Indergand) Flannery. He graduated from Monticello High School in 1969. Gaylord was married to Karin Pitman and later Vonnie Roosli. He was a dairy farmer for 40 years and then went to work for Federal Industries in Belleville for 10 years, retiring in June of 2021.
