Merle Frautschy, 69, Local Native, Dies

Funeral services for Merle Frautschy, 60 years of age, a native of Monticello, who died Friday at 7:30 p. m. in St. Joseph's hospital, Marshfield, were held at 2 Monday afternoon at the Voegeli funeral home here.

The Rev. John L. Walker, Evansville, Methodist minister officiated, and interment was in Highland cemetery here. Pallbearers were Arnold Ayers, Brodhead, Francis Atkinson, Cleveland, Walter Fahrney, William Zimmerli and Frank Moyer, Albany.

Mr. Frautschy had been hospitalized for six weeks.

Born in Monticello June 3, 1902, he was the son of Edward and Elvira Tone Frautschy. He grew up in Monticello and on Sept. 27, 1922, he was united in marriage to Gladys Jones in Albany. They lived in Albany and Evansville before moving to Stevens Point three years ago. They moved to Marshfield last summer when Mr. Frautschy's health failed.

Mr. Frautschy was a member of the Masonic lodge.

He is survived by his wife; one son, Robert M., Marshfield; his step-mother, Mrs. Marie Dinges, Monroe; one sister; Mrs. Ila Morrell, Madison; and two grandchildren.
