J. C. Freitag Found Dead in Garage

MONTICELLO—J. C. Freitag, 76, president of the Bank of Monticello since 1904, was found dead in a chair in the garage of his home here Monday afternoon. Wendell Barlow, cashier of the bank, found the body. He said the ignition key was on in the car, but the motor was not running and there were no fumes present. He added there was no gasoline in the tank.

Freitag was a well-known Monticello citizen, having been a member of the Green county board, the village board of trustees and of the local Masonic chapter.

He was born in Exeter township and had always lived in this area. He married Mary Hoesly in 1885. She died in 1939. They had no children. Mr. Freitag left no immediate survivors.

The body was taken to the Voegeli funeral home here.
