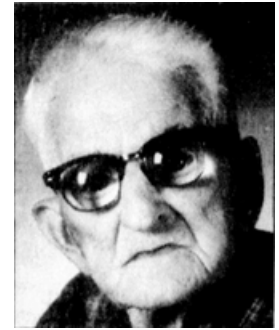


Terrence E. Freitag
September 22, 1902 - October 18, 1997

NEW GLARUS/MONROE - Terrence E. Freitag, age 95, passed away on Saturday, October 18, 1997, at Pleasant View Nursing Home, where he had resided the past four and one-half years.



He was born September 22, 1902 at Monticello, the second of 15 children born to Jacob H. and Emma Jordi Freitag. He married Frieda Luchsinger on November 5, 1927. Terrence farmed for most of his adult life, and upon quitting farming was employed by the Pet Milk Company until its New Glarus plant closed. He then worked in maintenance at the Green County Farm until retirement. In earlier years, he greatly enjoyed fishing and hunting, as well as listening to and watching baseball and football games on radio and TV.

Terrence is survived by two daughters, Mardelle Quest of Monroe and Carolyn (William) McNary of Dayton, Washington; two sons, Harold (Molly) Freitag and Alan (Jean) Freitag, both of Verona, Wisconsin; seven grandchildren, Steven, Scott and Stacey McNary and Kelly (Kevin) Iverson, all of the Seattle, Washington area, Dan (Linda) Freitag of Verona, Wisconsin, Hal (Shelly) Freitag of Novi, Michigan, and Terri Mills of Madison, Wisconsin; and two great-grandchildren, Carrie Mills and Michael Freitag.
