Mrs. Ursula Freitag Dies At Monticello

Mrs. Ursula Freitag, aged 85, passed away at 2:15 P. M. Thursday morning at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Fred Moser, at Monticello. She had been bedfast the past two and a half weeks following a stroke.

Ursula Blumer, a daughter of John and Marie Stuessy Blumer, was born in town Washington Sept. 30, 1854. In June, 1872 she was married to Henry Freitag at New Glarus. They lived on a farm north of Monticello until moving to the village in 1901.

Surviving are: seven daughters and three sons, Mrs. Mary Gottier, Footville; Jacob H. Freitag, Mrs. Anna Hefty, Mrs. Lizzie Zentner and Mrs. Fred Moser, Monticello; Henry T. Freitag, New Glarus; Mrs. Rose Durst, Dayton, Ohio; Edward Freitag, Eau Claire; Mrs. Emma Bagley, Albany and Mrs. Carrie Schuler, Madison; two brothers, Jacob Blumer, Orfordville and Sam Blumer, Delavan and 41. grand-children.

She was preceded in death by her husband, parents. one child, three sisters, three half-sisters, one brother and two half-brothers.

Mrs. Freitag was a member of the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church at Monticello.

Funeral services were held there Saturday afternoon, Rev. A. R. Achtemeier officiating. Burial was in the church cemetery.
