**John Frick, 55, New Glarus, Succumbs**

John Frick, 55 years of age, a former cheesemaker in Monticello, died at 2 a. m. Sunday of a heart attack in his home in New Glarus.

Funeral services were held at 1:30 Wednesday afternoon at the Zentner funeral home, New Glarus, with the Rev. Linus Wierwill of the Swiss United Church of Christ, officiating. Interment was in the Swiss church cemetery in New Glarus.

A native of Switzerland, Mr. Frick was born April 4, 1909, the son of John and Elisa Lueggensberger Frick. He came to the United States in 1925 and settled in the Gratiot area.

He was a cheesemaker in Monticello for a number of years. On Jan. 30, 1939, he was united in marriage to Anna Verena Zimmerman, They lived in Nora, Ill, for several years, and then moved to the Blanchardville area, where he was a cheesemaker. In 1950 they moved to New Glarus, where Mr, Frick was employed by the Pet Milk company for several years.

He is survived by his wife; one daughter, Mary Ann, and two sons, John Jacob and Joseph Anton, all at home, and one brother, Theodore, in Switzerland. He was preceded in death. by his parents.
