**Glen M. Geigel, 58, Monroe, Dies**

Funeral services for Glen M. Geigel, 58 years of age, former Mt. Pleasant township farmer, who had made his home in Monroe since 1938, and who passed away Sunday at the Monroe hospital after a long illness, were held at 1:30 p. m. Wednesday at the Immanuel Evangelical United Brethren church, Monroe.

The Rev. Howard L. Orians, church pastor, officiated, and burial was in Greenwood cemetery, Monroe.

Mr. Geigel's death terminated a long illness.

Mr. Geigel was born in Mt. Pleasant township and was married in 1919 in Juda to the former Lydia Witchelt. The Geigels farmed south of Monticello until 1938. For the past seven years Mr. Geigel had been employed at the Cheese Producers Marketing Association warehouse, Monroe.
