## Rites Held Saturday P. M. for Albert Gempeler, Age 64

Funeral services for Albert Gempeler, 64 years of age, esteemed Washington township resident, who passed away at 10:50 p.m. on Wednesday of last week at the St. Clare hospital, Monroe, were held at 2 Saturday afternoon at the Zwingli Evangelical and Reformed church.
