Howard F. Gould, 83, Belleville, died unexpectedly on Tuesday, Aug. 31, 1993, at his home.

He was born March 27, 1910 in Exeter Township, Green County, Wisconsin, the son of Clarence and Emma (Edwards) Gould. On Oct. 22, 1935 he was united in marriage to the former Frieda E. Schulz at Monticello. The couple farmed in Exeter township until 1980 when they retired to the village of Belleville. Howard had farmed for a total of 62 years on the home farm.

He was a member of the First United Church of Christ, Belleville, the Belleville Senior Citizen Singers, sexton of the Exeter Cemetery, and an avid hunter and fisherman who enjoyed the outdoors.

Survivors include his wife, Freida E. Gould, Belleville; two daughters, Fran (Lee) Eriksen, Portage, and Diane (Daniel) McPhail, Belleville; and three grandchildren, Pamela, Scott and LeRoy McPhail, all of Belleville.

Preceding him in death were his parents, and a sister, Mildred.

Funeral services were held on Friday, Sept. 3, at the First United Church of Christ, Belleville, the Pastor Don Nelson officiated, with burial in the Belleville Cemetery.
