MONROE — T. Herman Graber, 78, died Thursday (Feb. 24, 1972) in a hospital after a brief illness.

A native of Switzerland, Mr. Graber came to America in 1914, returning to Switzerland in 1932 to marry the former Emma Ablanap.

They returned to this country to farm in the Monticello area from 1945 until retiring here in 1968.
