Funeral services for George Graf, 89, Monticello, who died Tuesday, Oct. 24, in the New Glarus Home, will be at 2:30 p.m. Thursday, Oct. 26, in the Zwingli United Church of Christ Memorial Lounge in Monticello. Rev. Charles G. Workman is to officiate. Burial will be in Highland Cemetery.

Pallbearers for Mr. Graf, a longtime Monticello businessman and a former cheesemaker, will be Donald F. Marti, Warren Prisk, John L. Streiff, Dwight Zweifel, and Zane Zurbuchen, all of Monticello, and Kenneth M. Streiff, New Glarus.

Mr. Graf was born in Switzerland, a son of John and Marie Montoulies Graf. He was married there in 1920 to Lena Buhlmann and they came to America shortly afterwards. They had made cheese and operated the Chateau Tavern in Monticello many years.

He was a member of Zwingli Church and the Monticello Community Club.

Mr. Graf's only immediate survivor is his widow, Lena, now at the New Glarus Home, after sustaining a fractured hip in a fall.
